Bishop Irenei Celebrates the Patronal Feastday of the Parish of St John the Wonderworker in Belfast, Northern Ireland

These included a visit to Downpatrick, where the grave of St Patrick of Ireland was venerated by the Bishop and fellow pilgrims, as well as the holy wells in Struel, sanctified by St Patrick, located nearby. In the evening, following the Divine Services, parishioners gathered

for spiritual talk with Bishop Irenei.
