Greek FM Dendias will meet with Archbishop Anastasios of Tirana, Durres and All Albania on Tuesday



Foreign Affairs Minister Nikos Dendias will visit Albania on Tuesday, where he will meet with the country's political leadership.

He will first meet with Acting Foreign Minister of Albania Gent Cakaj, before meeting with Albanian Prime Minister Edi Rama and President Ilir Meta.

Talks will focus on issues of bilateral, European and regional interest, with an emphasis on the course of Greek-Albanian relations, developments in the Eastern Mediterranean region and the European perspective of the Western Balkans, says a ministry statement.
