Greece reportedly requests EU weapons embargo against belligerent, war-mongering Erdogan gov't



Press reports in Athens on Tuesday maintained that Greek Foreign Minister Nikos Dendias has sent letters to his German, Spanish and Italian counterparts detailing Ankara's recent belligerent actions in the eastern Mediterranean, while at the same time requesting a weapons embargo against Erdogan-led Turkey.

Moreover, Dendias has sent a letter to EU enlargement and neighborhood minister Olivér Várelyi, reportedly requesting deliberation over a possible suspension of the EU-Turkey customs union, due to Ankara's violations of customs and legislative violations.
