The Feast of Venerable Paraskeva celebrated at the Metropolitan Cathedral in Chisinau, Moldova

With the blessing of the hierarch, archpriest Vadim Cheibas, the Cathedral Dean, delivered a message of pastoral guidance, speaking about the significance of the feast and about the life of Venerable Paraskeva, "a model of Christian life in an increasingly desacralized society".

In the end, Metropolitan Vladimir blessed the liturgical community and congratulated the church-going on the Feast, wishing to all spiritual growth.
