Holy Synod of Church of Greece convenes for a second day



Members of the Holy Synod of the Autocephalous Orthodox Church of Greece met for a second day this week on Thursday, with hierarchs anxiously awaiting news on how a general Covid-19 lockdown will affect houses of worship and the holding of services and sacraments with worshippers.
