New Orthodox parish cathedral in Stockholm



This week witnessed the completion of the transfer of a cathedral in downtown Stockholm to the Holy Metropolis of Sweden and all Scandinavia.

In a statement after the signing of a donation contract, the Metropolitan Sweden and All Scandinavia, His Eminence Cleopas, expressed his deep gratitude to the donors for the new parish, which will be dedicated to neomartyr St. George of loannina.

The 250-square-meter church was built in 1890, and in addition to the main building includes three adjacent rooms.
