Metropolitan of Volokolamsk: Russian Church views support of suffering Christians in Africa as part of its historical mission



The Russian Orthodox Church's Metropolitan of Volokolamsk, His Eminence Hilarion, this week spoke at an online conference focusing on the situation of Christians in Africa.

His Eminence, who is also the head of the Moscow Patriarchate's Department for External Church Relations, said Christian churches and organizations should join in an alliance to more effectively work to protect African Christians, who face severe persecution in many countries, as he underlined.
