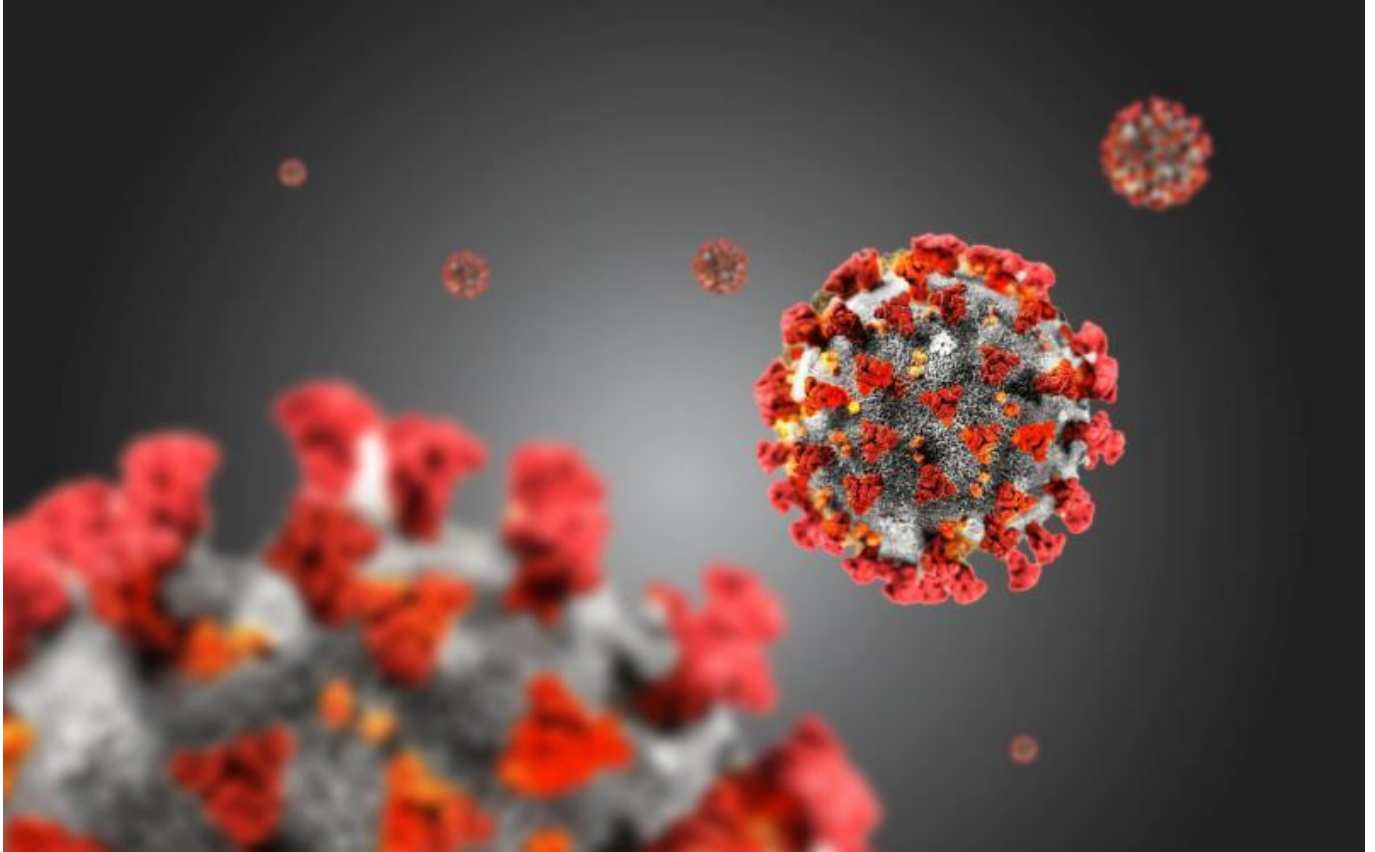


Scientific advisory com't of Orthodox Christian Health Care Providers to evaluate, present information regarding pandemic



A scientific advisory committee comprised of Orthodox Christian Health Care Providers from around the world, in cooperation with the St. Maximus the Greek Institute, will initiate actions dealing with scientific evaluation and the presentation of information to the public regarding the ongoing pandemic.

A relevant press release noted that "...The St. Maxim the Greek Institute is called upon during this period to contribute to and assist with, in any way and by any means at its disposal, the task of health service providers, from a medical standpoint. The Church is also required, through its clergy, to engage with pastoral issues, since the clergy are also charged with giving support to the people of God who are being tested by the threat and fear of the pandemic."

The Institute announced that it aspires to contribute to the best understanding of the meaning of our life, given that today our social models have become degraded, institutions are under attack and there is an obvious and incontrovertible decline in the quality of life, just at the time when people are desperately attempting to find their identity and their place in the world.
