Earthquake damaged Serbian churches in Sisak and Petrinja

- The damage to the church of St. Petka and the parish house in Sisak is such that worship services and life in them are permanently disabled. Priests from Sisak and Petrinja and their families were forced to leave their homes, priest Veselin Ristic, a parish priest from Sisak, told this to the Information Service of the Serbian Orthodox Church.
