Greek FM addresses Athens-based Society of Imvros natives



Greek Foreign Minister Nikos Dendias this week addressed, via a remote connection, then annual New Year's pie-cutting ceremony held by the Athensbased Society of Imvros natives.

Dendias made a particular reference to the Ecumenical Patriarch of Constantinople, His All Holiness Bartholomew I, himself a native of the northeast Aegean island that was handed to Turkey with the 1923 Treaty of Lausanne.
