The conference will take place on Sunday, January 24, 2021, at 14:30 (Athens time), on the occasion of the celebration of the World Education Day and the bicentennial of the 1821 Greek Revolution, and is organized by the General Secretariat for Higher Education of the Ministry of Education and Religious Affairs and the General Secretariat for Public Diplomacy and Greeks Abroad of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
