## New Serbian Patriarch meets with country's president



The general secretary of the Inter-Parliamentary Assembly of Orthodoxy, Greek lawmaker Maximos Harakopoulos, in a congratulatory letter to the new Patriarch of the Serbian Orthodox Church, His Holiness Porfirije, noted that "...the Serbian people maintained its identity and preserved its valuable spiritual heritage, despite the adversity and the assaults it faced through the centuries, even recently, through its Orthodox tradition."

The message came as His Holiness met on Wednesday with the President of Serbia, Alexander Vucic.
