

Saturday of Souls Memorial Services at HCHC



In the Greek Orthodox Church, there is an important and longstanding tradition of praying to God for our departed brothers and sisters. Saturday is the day of the week which is traditionally reserved for those who have fallen asleep, because our Lord's own salvific passing took place on Great and Holy Saturday.

While each Saturday provides an opportunity for the remembrance of those who have fallen asleep, the next three Saturdays are called the "Saturday of Souls," which are designated specifically for this purpose.
