Serbian Patriarch receives Ambassador of the Republic of Greece



His Holiness Porfirije, Serbian Patriarch received His Excellency Georgios Diacofotakis, the Ambassador of the Republic of Greece to the Republic of Serbia, at the Serbian Patriarchate in Belgrade, on 24 March 2021.

In a more than cordial conversation with Ambassador Djakofotakis, Serbian Patriarch Porfirije expressed gratitude to the state leadership of the Republic of Greece, as well as to the Ambassador himself, for congratulations on the election and enthronement of the Primate of the Serbian Orthodox Church.
