

A doctoral training course entitled: “Critical Studies of Arabic Manuscripts, Archives, and Inscriptions”



The St John of Damascus Institute of Theology, University of Balamand, in collaboration with several local and international universities and academic institutions, has organized a doctoral training course entitled: “Critical Studies of Arabic Manuscripts, Archives, and Inscriptions” from 4 till 8 February 2019, in Balamand, Kaslik and Beirut.

The doctoral training is a two weeks workshop, equivalent to 3 credits course in Higher education, organized by: Centre National de la Recherche Scientifique (CNRS) with its subdepartments: IRHT, LEM; Institut Français du Proche Orient (IFPO); Bibliothèque Nationale de France (BNF); Agence Universitaire de la Francophonie (AUF); Université Libanaise (UL); University of Balamand (UOB); Université Saint Esprit de Kaslik (USEK); Université Saint-Joseph (USJ) : CEDRAC, BO; Service de Coopération et d’Action Culturelle de l’Ambassade de France au

Liban (SCAC). The doctoral training is held in one partner university each day.

St John of Damascus Institute of Theology - UOB hosted all the participants in this training on Tuesday 5th February 2019 from 9.30am to 4.00pm.

This training course will continue in a second session in May 2019, likewise in Beirut, Kaslik and Balamand.
