

## Children's Day in the Archdiocese of Bucharest



Patriarch Daniel sent on Monday consistent gifts for 280 children from the Archdiocese of Bucharest. Beneficiaries were the 40 children who receive social support at the eparchy's "St Sophia" Day Care Center and the children of clerics who serve in rural parishes of the second and third category.
