AHEPA OMEGA 371 Feast Day Gifts for Area Parishes



Each year the AHEPA Omega Detroit Chapter 371 gives \$3,000 to each of five churches in the Detroit metro area where its members are parishioners on the Feast Day of each church's patron saint. Recent contributions were given on April 23rd to St. George Church, Southgate, MI and on May 21st to the Saints Constantine and Helen Church, Westland, MI. The contribution is made as a demonstration AHEPA's long-standing support of Orthodox churches, and the Greek Orthodox Metropolis of Detroit.

The Omega Chapter 371's annual budget includes helping Metropolis of Detroit parishes in various ways throughout the year. In addition to feast day donations, each year the chapter provides funds to its five area churches to support their family assistance programs and makes available scholarships to students that participate in Orthodox Christian Fellowship ("OCF") programs. The Omega Chapter 371 was recently awarded the Making the Difference Award at the AHEPA District 10 convention in recognition of their assistance to area churches during the COVID-19 pandemic.
