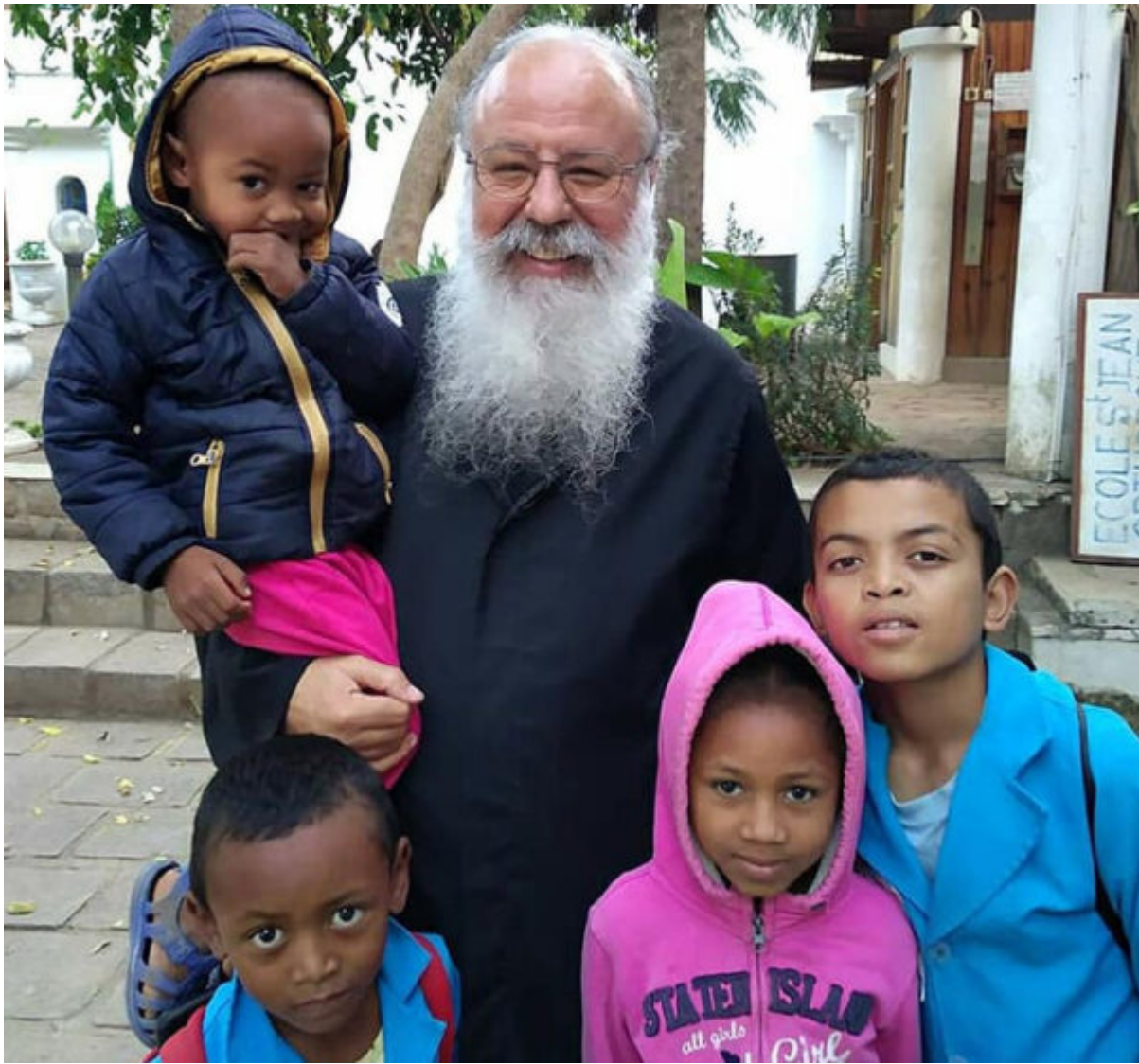
NEW CONVENT UNDER CONSTRUCTION IN MADAGASCAR
