US President Biden phones Ecumenical Patriarch, offers best wishes for speedy recovery



The Ecumenical Patriarch of Constantinople, His All-Holiness Bartholomew I, received a phone call from US President Joe Biden on Monday evening, with the American leader expressing his best wishes for the former's speedy recovery from a stent procedure last week in Manhattan.

The Primate of the Mother Church departed from New York City on Sunday afternoon for Constantinople, after concluding a prominent and very productive two-week Apostolic tour in the United States.
