More images show destruction, vandalism of Christian sites in occupied Cyprus



More heartbreaking images from the Turkish-occupied areas of Cyprus came to the limelight this week, showing ruined churches and vandalized cemeteries, nearly half a century after the barbaric Turkish invasion of the island republic and the continued illegal occupation of one-third of the EU member-state's territory.
