

Greek PM to address joint US Congressional session on Tues.



Greek Prime Minister Kyriakos Mitsotakis arrived in Washington over the weekend for talks this afternoon, local time, with US President Joe Biden at the White House. Afterwards, he will attend a reception in his honor given by the US president.

On Tuesday, Mitsotakis will arrive at the US Capitol for a meeting with US House of Representatives Speaker Nancy Pelosi.

Immediately afterwards, he will become the first Greek leader to address a joint Congressional session of the US Senate and House of Representatives.

According to numerous media reports emanating from the Greek capital, ahead of the official visit, Mitsotakis and his government aim to re-affirm the strategic relationship between the two countries, while entrenching Greece's role as an emerging energy hub in the wider region.
