University of Balamand, Institute of Theology - A Lecture titled: “Artificial Intelligence and Theology”



Under the High Patronage of His Beatitude Patriarch John X of Antioch and All the East, a lecture titled “Artificial Intelligence and Theology” was presented at the Saint John of Damascus Institute of Theology at the University of Balamand on Tuesday, April 16, 2019 and on Thursday, April 18, 2019.
