

The 36th Annual Metropolis of Boston Ministry Awards Celebration

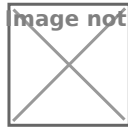

Over 700 clergy and laity gathered at the Metropolis of Boston 36th Annual Ministry Awards Celebration on Sunday, June 12th, 2022 at Gillette Stadium, Foxborough, MA. The Master of Ceremony for the evening was Peter Eliopoulos, an Emmy Award winning reporter for WCVB- NewsCenter5.

This year's event was extra special with the milestone of His Eminence Metropolitan Methodios' 40th Anniversary of his ordination to the Episcopacy. The attendees enjoyed the Dance Performance of The Sons and Daughters of Alexander the Great Dance Group which is celebrating its 50 years of establishment as a Greek Dance Group under the leadership of George Papadopoulos.

The Honorable Stratos Efthymiou, Consul General of Greece in Boston conveyed his congratulations to His Eminence and all the parishes and individuals who were honored. His Eminence expressed his great appreciation to the Honorable Efthymiou for his dedication and contributions to the Greek American community.

At the conclusion of the Ministry Awards Dinner, over 150 young adults from all of New England gathered for the After Hour Greek Night at the Putnam Club for music, dancing, fellowship and fun.
