## Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew officiates at Divine Liturgy for Ukrainian-, Russian-speaking Orthodox faithful



The Ecumenical Patriarch of Constantinople, His All Holiness Bartholomew I, on Sunday paid a pastoral visit to the Diocese of the historic Marmara Sea port of Panormos, known today as Bandirma, where he met with the local Ukrainian- and Russian-speaking Orthodox faithful.
