

Assembly of Bishops and Agencies Present at Greek Archdiocese's Clergy Laity



NEW YORK – The Assembly of Canonical Orthodox Bishops of the United States of America and its six Agencies – IOCC, OCMC, OCF, OCPM, OVC, and OYM – engaged with the clergy and laity at the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of America's biennial congress, commemorating the centennial of the Archdiocese.

The panel discussion began with testimonials from beneficiaries of the various Agencies as well as the Assembly's Mental Health Ministries. Following the powerful videos, representatives from each organization – including Dean Triantafiliou, Fr. Martin Ritsi, Dn.
