V. Rev. Archimandrite Chrysostom Onyekakeyah Participates in 29th Annual National Conference of the Fellowship of Saint Moses the Black

Archimandrite Chrysostom Onyekakeyah, Project Coordinator for Mission and Outreach Development for the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of America, with the blessing of His Eminence Archbishop Elpidoforos of America, attended the 29th Annual National Conference of the Fellowship of Saint Moses the Black held between October 14-16, 2022, at the parish of St. Moses the Black Orthodox church in Pittsburgh, PA with the theme “Baptizing Culture”. The Mission of the Fellowship is to equip Orthodox Christians for the ministry of Racial Reconciliation, and to share the Orthodox Christian Faith with African Americans and all people of color.
