Before the dismissal of the Divine Liturgy, His Eminence Metropolitan Ieronimos of [unclear], and on the Holy









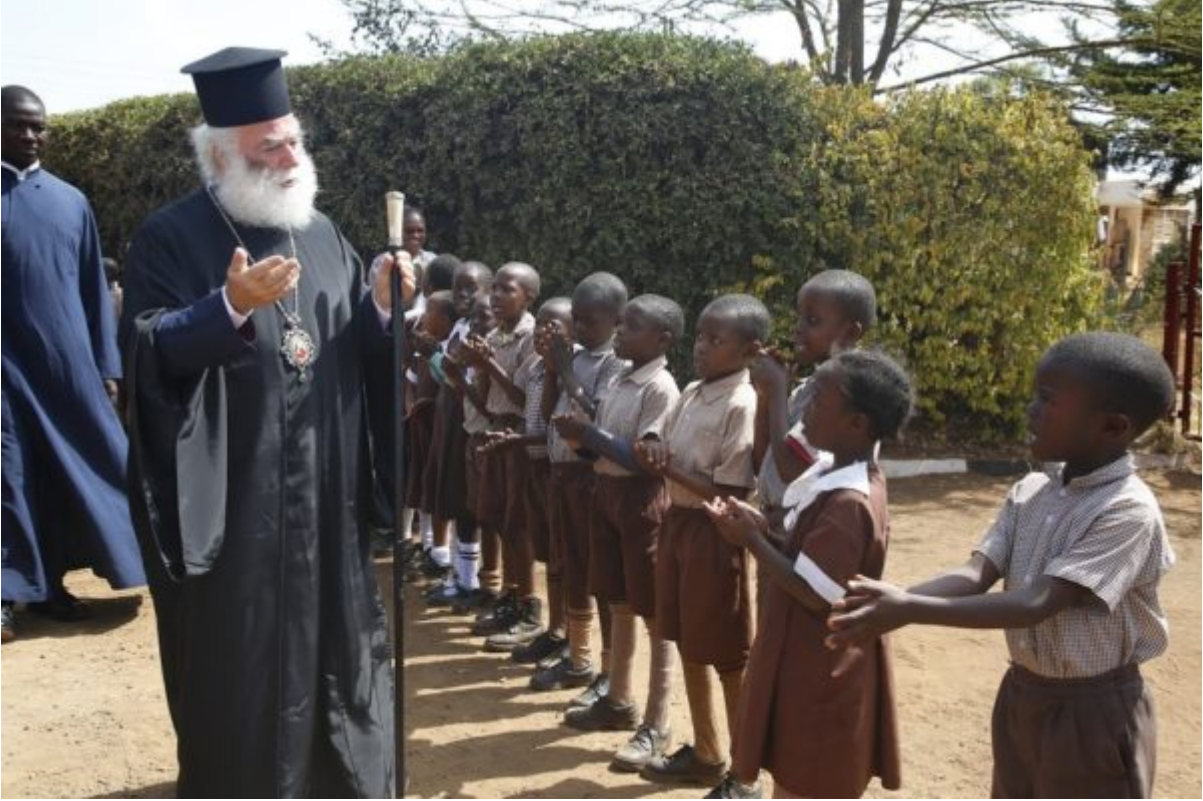
