## **Presidents of USA and Ukraine at the Cathedral of Saint Michael in Kyiv**



On Monday, 20 February 2023, President of the United States of America, Mr. Joe Biden, visited Kyiv in a visit of solidarity.

As part of the visit, the President of the United States, Joe Biden, and the President of Ukraine, Volodymyr Zelensky, visited the gilded St. Michael's Cathedral, where they were welcomed by His Beatitude Metropolitan of Kyiv and All Ukraine, Epiphaniy.
