Patriarch of All Romania, Daniel; Archbishop of Warsaw & Metropolitan of All Poland Sava on commencement of Great Lent



The Patriarch of All Romania, His Beatitude Daniel, on Clean Monday, the first day of the Great Lent ahead of Pascha, Holy Easter for 2023, referred to the spiritual preparation by the faithful, one that leads to experiencing the Passion of the Lord and Savior and the Resurrection.

His Beatitude spoke from the Patriarchal chapel of St. George in Bucharest.

Finally, from another part of Europe, the Archbishop of Warsaw and Metropolitan of All Poland, His Beatitude Sava, called on the faithful to remain true to all the expressions that the life of an Orthodox Christian may reveal, amidst the difficult current conditions arise in society.

His Beatitude spoke on the occasion of the commencement of Great Lent, which he reminded begins with the forgiveness of our brothers.
