## Gerontissa Kallistheni offers spiritual talk to the youth of the Archdiocesan District of Melbourne





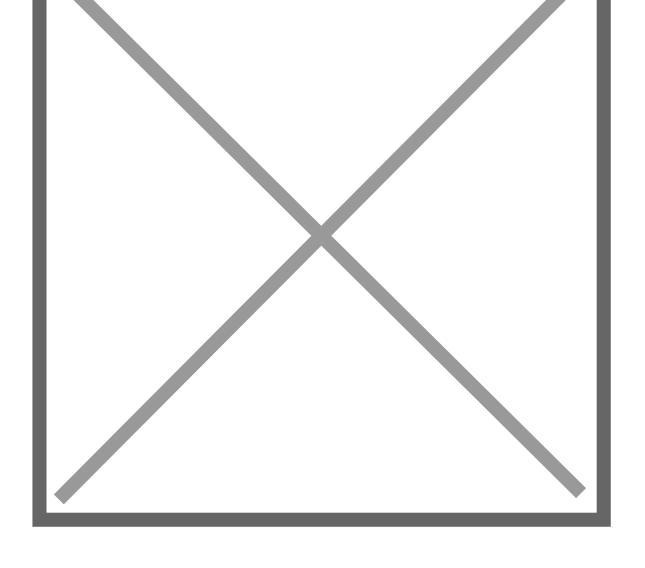



Gerontissa related the hymn, which centers on the theme of repentance, to our day-to-day lives. She encouraged the youth to have the courage for self-examination without despair and to glorify God for everything.

Gerontissa also answered questions from the audience, providing spiritually enlightening advice on topics ranging from being a proud Orthodox Christian to learning to forgive others.
