## Patriarch Daniel bestows church distinction on Maramureş gendarme for reaching 100th blood donation



Cosmin Barabaş, a gendarme in the county of Maramureş in northern Romania, attained his 101st blood donation milestone as part of the Romanian Patriarchate's "Donate blood, save a life!" campaign.
