Erdogan again plays to supporters by referring to desecration of Hagia Sophia



Islamist Turkish leader Recep Tayyip Erdogan, the incumbent in the upcoming general elections in the country, again attempted to present the 2020 reconversion of the Hagia Sophia from a museum in a mosque as a "major achievement", speaking a few days ago.
