
Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew to celebrate Pascha in Imbros



His All-Holiness Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew ahead of Holy Week and Easter, will travel to his birthplace of Imbros. As the Holy Metropolis of Imbros and Tenedos informs in a respective announcement, His All-Holiness will lead all the Holy Services during the appointed period, while the announcement points out that this is the first visit of the Ecumenical Patriarch to his birthplace during the Paschal season after a decade.
