

More attacks in Kosovo against Christian Serbs



The Serbian Orthodox Bishop of Raska-Prizren, His Grace Teodosije, this week visited the people injured during a recent wave of violence in the province.

Concerns are heightened in the region after the spike of tensions in Kosovo, 20 years after the province unilaterally seceded from Serbia.

Persecution against Serbian Orthodox faithful by the predominately Albanian Muslim population continues, while historic Orthodox monasteries and places of worship continue to be guarded by NATO forces.
