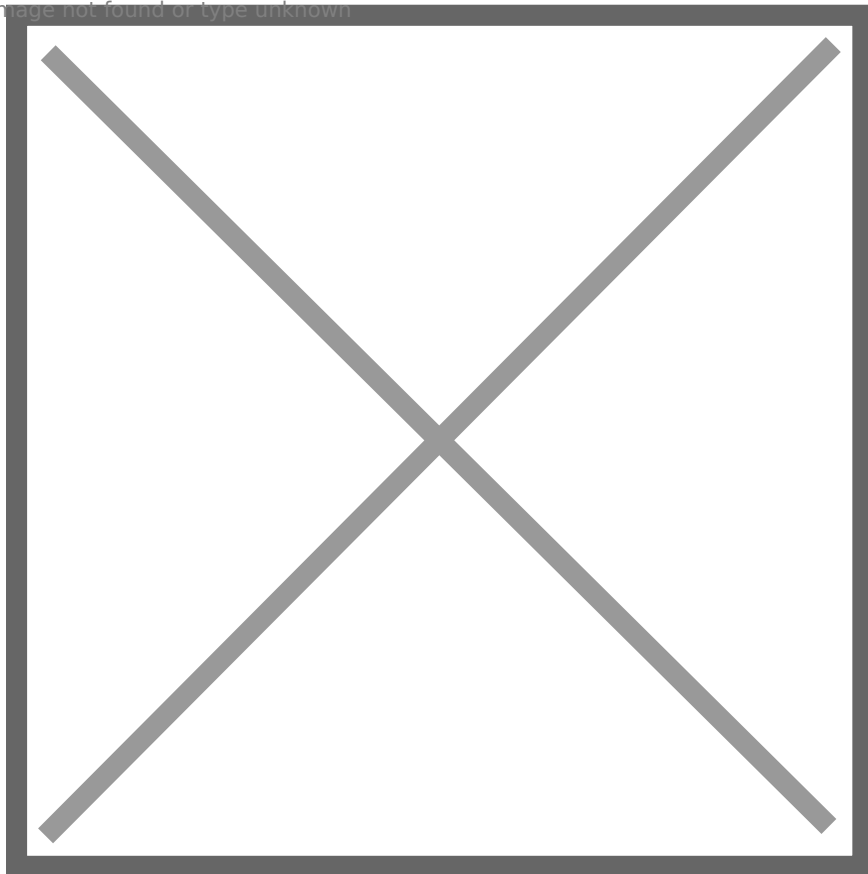

After the end of the Memorial, wreaths were laid in memory of the heroes.

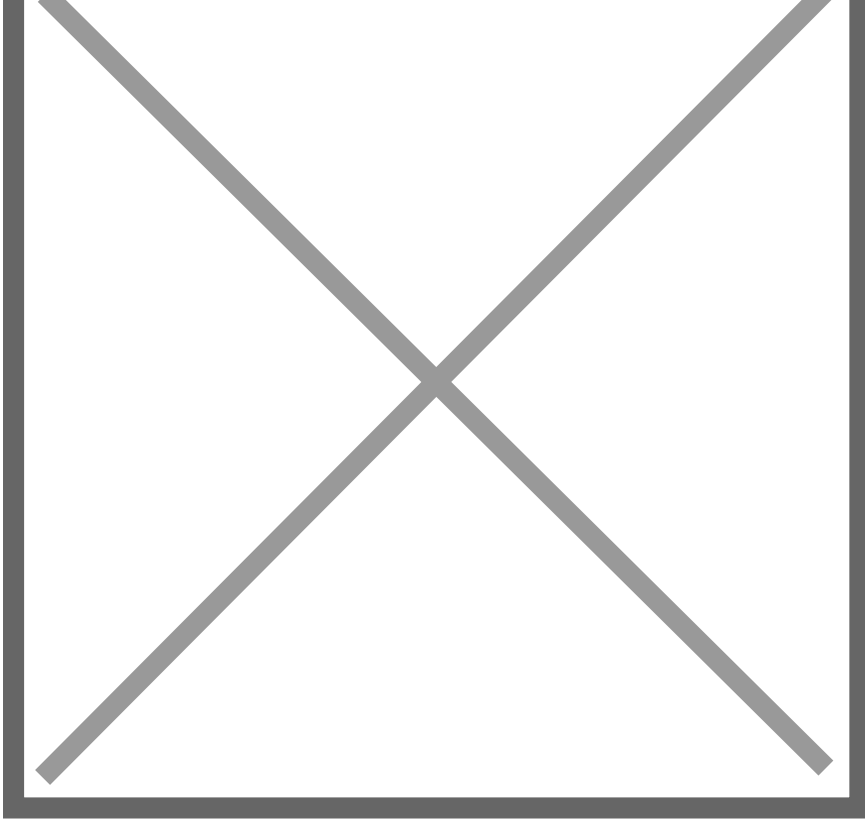

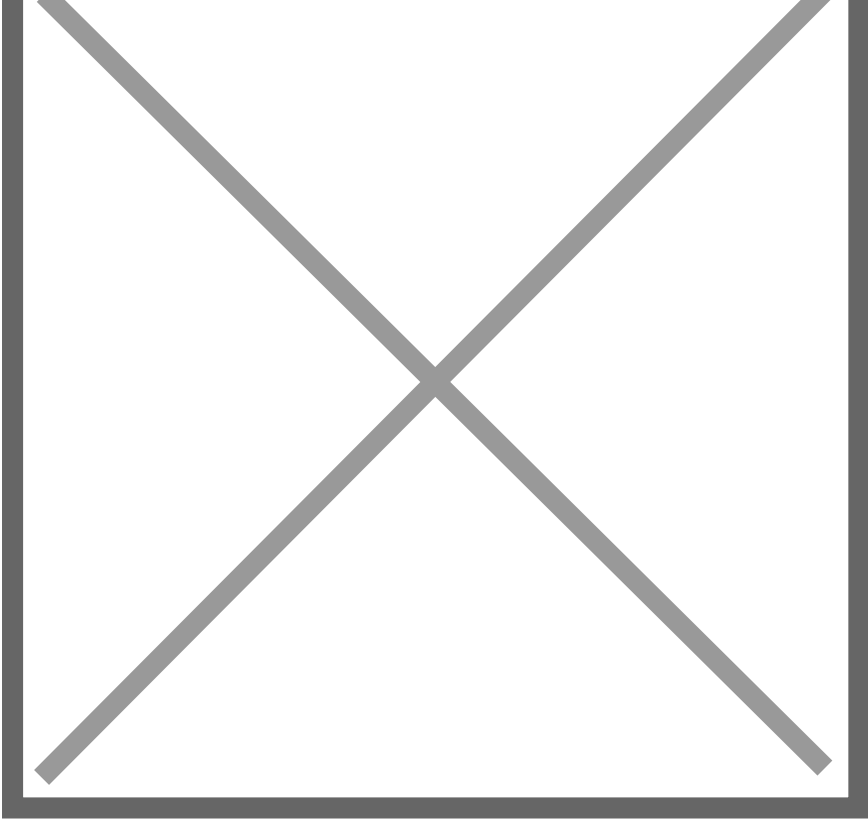
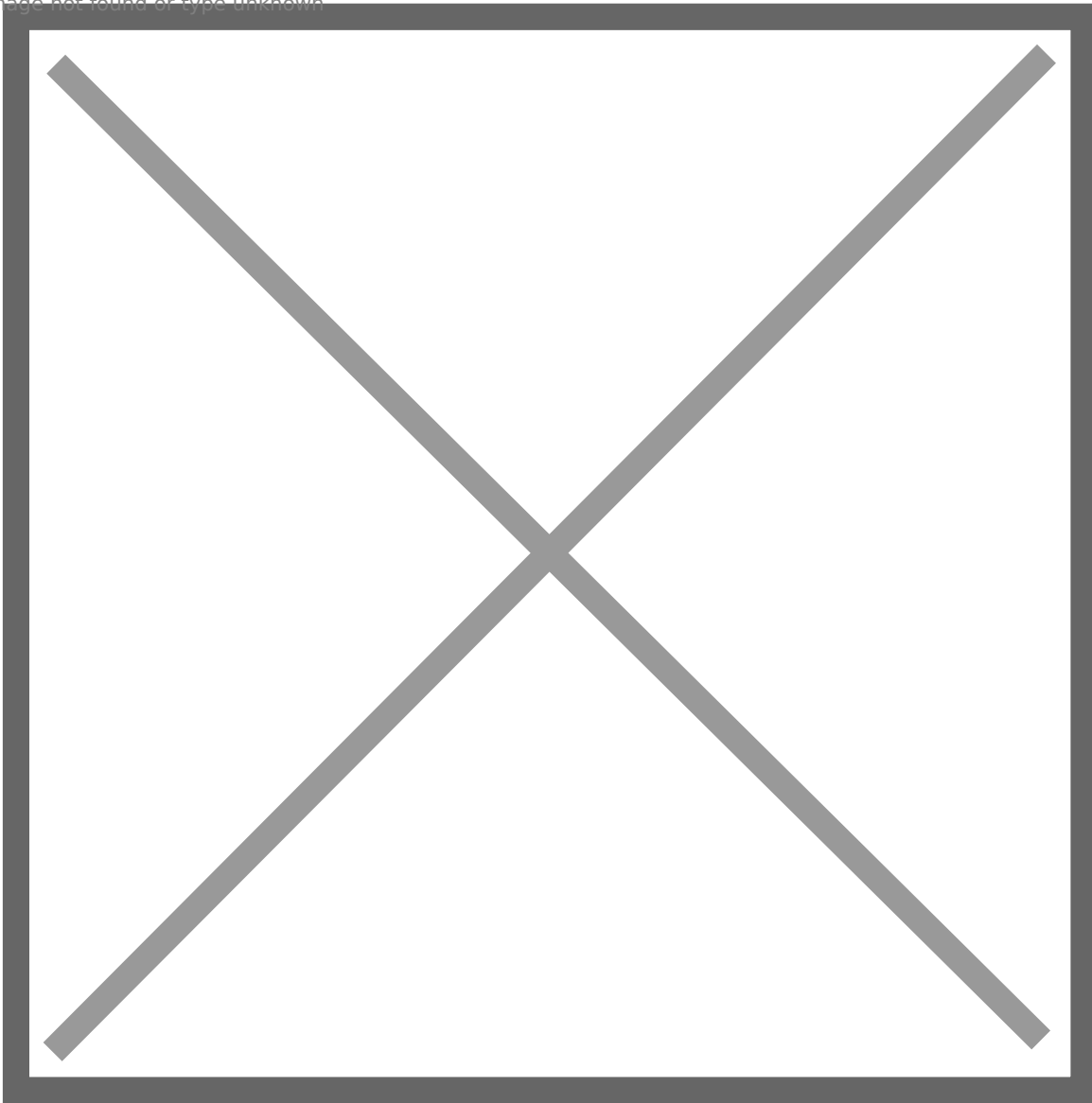
