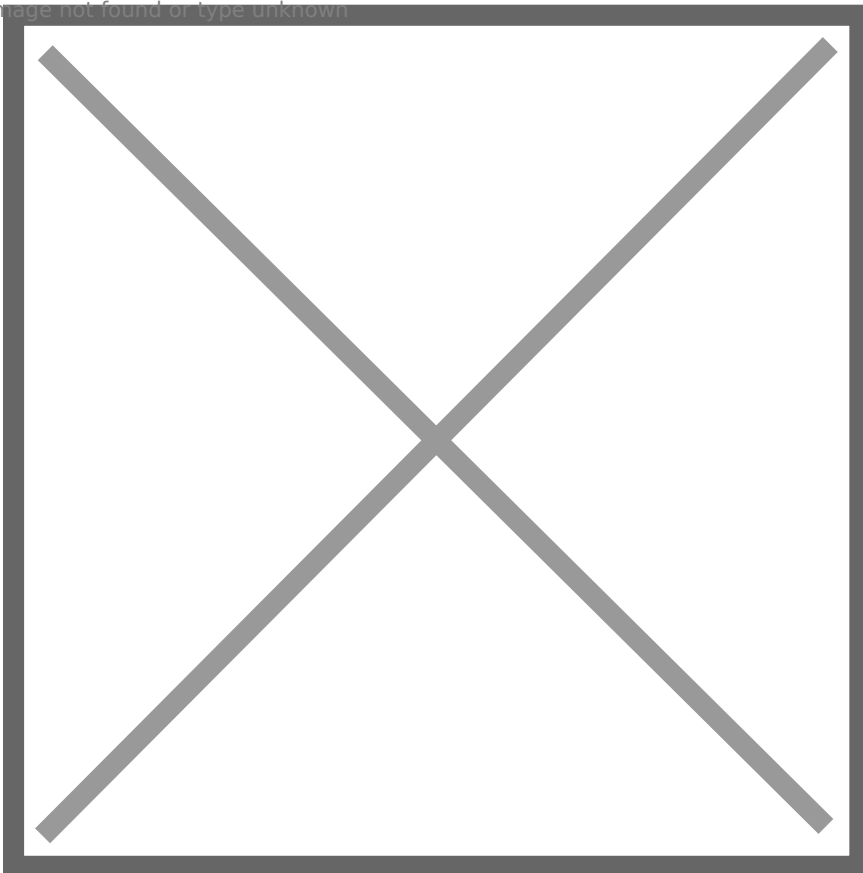
Metropolitan Panteleimon of Naucratis visits Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew
