Reports: Australian PM Morrison at enthronement ceremony for new Archbishop Makarios



The prime minister of Australia, Scott Morrison, will reportedly attend the enthronement of new Archbishop of Australia, His Eminence Makarios, according to exclusive information learned by the Orthodoxy news agency.

The same reports, in fact, note that the Australian leader has requested that he make a brief welcoming statement for the new Archbishop.

Beyond his significant work as a writer, academic and his spiritual presence, His Eminence, the new Primate of the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of Australia, enjoys an increasing popularity with the lay people, the clergy and the political leadership on the island continent.

In a related development, preparations are continuing at a feverish pace this week for the upcoming enthroning ceremony of the new Archbishop of America, His Eminence Elpidoforos.

The Archbishop-elect is expected to arrive in the United States on Wednesday, while the imposing enthronement ceremony will take place at 11 in the morning on Saturday, June 22, at the Holy Trinity Cathedral in Manhattan — in the presence of

religious leaders, representatives of the US and Greek governments, local officials and dignitaries from around the world.
