

Meeting of Archbishop Makarios of Australia with Bishop Themistocles of Nicopolis



His Eminence Archbishop Makarios of Australia held a private meeting with His Grace Bishop Themistocles of Nicopolis, of the Patriarchate of Alexandria, during his recent visit to Melbourne.

The Archbishop had the opportunity to be thoroughly informed about the missionary work that the Orthodox Church is carrying out on the African continent through the Patriarchate of Alexandria and All Africa.
