

Archbishop Elpidophoros Celebrates Consecration Weekend at Holy Trinity Cathedral Indianapolis, Indiana



From October 6-8 2023, His Eminence Archbishop Elpidophoros of America participated in the Consecration events of Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Cathedral in Indianapolis, Indiana. His Eminence led the Holy Rites of Consecration with His Eminence Metropolitan Nicholas of Detroit, Holy Trinity parish priest Rev. Fr. Gregory Hohnholt, Rev. Fr. William Bartz, Rev. Fr. James Rousakis, Rev. Fr. Lucas Christensen, Fr. Soterios Rousakis, Archdeacon Dionysios Papis, Deacon Petros Gomez, and Deacon Spiridon Morris.

The Holy Relics of Saints Barbara, Panteleimon, and Haralambos were entombed within the holy altar at Holy Trinity Cathedral. While processing the church during the Consecration, Parish Council Members Conner Larew and Grant Robbins carried the icon depicting the Holy Trinity. This icon was commissioned by Constantine Maniakas from George Kordis, Master Iconographer, as a gift for the Consecration. The icon is egg tempera on wood.

After the Great Vespers, the Archbishop elevated Fr. Gregory Hohnholt to Protopresbyter. His Eminence also presented a medal to Archon Dr. Dennis K. Dickos, honoring him with the highest honor of distinction for a lay person within

the Archdiocese.
