

## **Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of America Grants \$450,000 in Scholarships**

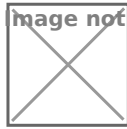

The Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of America is pleased to announce that it has granted \$450,000 in scholarships to over 95 students, for the 2023-2024 academic year. These scholarships represent a significant increase in the number of recipients and aggregate dollar amounts over 2022. The principal scholarships administered by the Archdiocese include:

The Gioles and Malta Scholarships, available to undergraduate students.

The Paleologos Scholarship, available to graduate students.

The Trakatellis Scholarship, available to graduates of Holy Cross Greek Orthodox School of Theology who are pursuing further academic studies.

The Taylor Scholarship, available to students pursuing a post-graduate degree in the areas of theology, religious studies or pastoral training.

The Tembelis Scholarship, available to students pursuing any degree at Hellenic College – Holy Cross Greek Orthodox School of Theology

The Grant Committees, appointed each year by His Eminence Archbishop Elpidophoros of America, consisted of men and women from a wide variety of ministerial and professional experience. Each application was carefully reviewed to determine eligibility and assessment of need.

The funds for the scholarships of the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese are primarily made available by endowments established by donors for specific educational purposes and are managed by professional investment advisors.
