

Ecumenical Patriarch was awarded an Honorary Doctorate from University of West Attica, Greece



His All-Holiness Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew was awarded an Honorary Doctorate from the Department of Conservation of Antiquities and Works of Art of the School of Applied Arts and Culture of the University of West Attica. The ceremony was held at the premises of the Association of Athenians in Plaka on Wednesday, October 11, 2023.

Mr. Eleftherios Skiadas, the President of the Association of Athens, said in his speech: "A bright day has dawned in the Association of Athens, as we have the pleasure of collaborating with the University of West Attica. It is a special day in its 126-year course, because we are given the opportunity to welcome the most important figure of Orthodoxy, the Ecumenical Patriarch."
