Perth: His Grace Bishop Elpidios of Kyanea Meets with the Church Committee of Sts Constantine and Helene



On Tuesday the 17 October 2023, His Grace Bishop Elpidios of Kyanea held a meeting with the Church Committee of Sts Constantine and Helene. The meeting was hosted by His Grace in the offices of the Archdiocesan District of Perth located in Dianella.

His Grace opened the meeting with prayer and a spiritual reflection on hope and the importance of persevering from the recently translated book of His Eminence Archbishop Makarios of Australia titled “The Priestly Ethos”. His Grace commended the Church Committee for their initiative and continuous hard work in the Parish and encouraged them all to stay united with one other, under the guidance of their Parish Priest, Fr Terry Gerovasilis, and the leadership of His Eminence.
