He then commented on certain points from the Typikon of the Holy Services of the Orthodox Church and

the important role the choir members play in the harmonious celebration of the Divine Liturgy.

After that, the choir members participated in Saturday's Great Vespers and all had dinner together. Fr. Roman Kavchak and Fr. Anthony Lim with Presbytera Lillian and Theodote participated in the Dinner.
