“In the Orthodox Church the word “failure” does not exist, because there exists the word “opportunity”

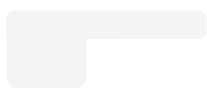
In the Orthodox Church, distance does not separate or alienate people. What separates and alienates people from one another is silence and ignorance.

In the Orthodox Church, anger is not an emotion that helps you to vindicate yourself. Anger is an emotional punishment you impose upon yourself for the errors of others.

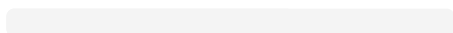
In the Orthodox Church the verb "I judge" does not exist because there exists the verb "I LOVE"!
