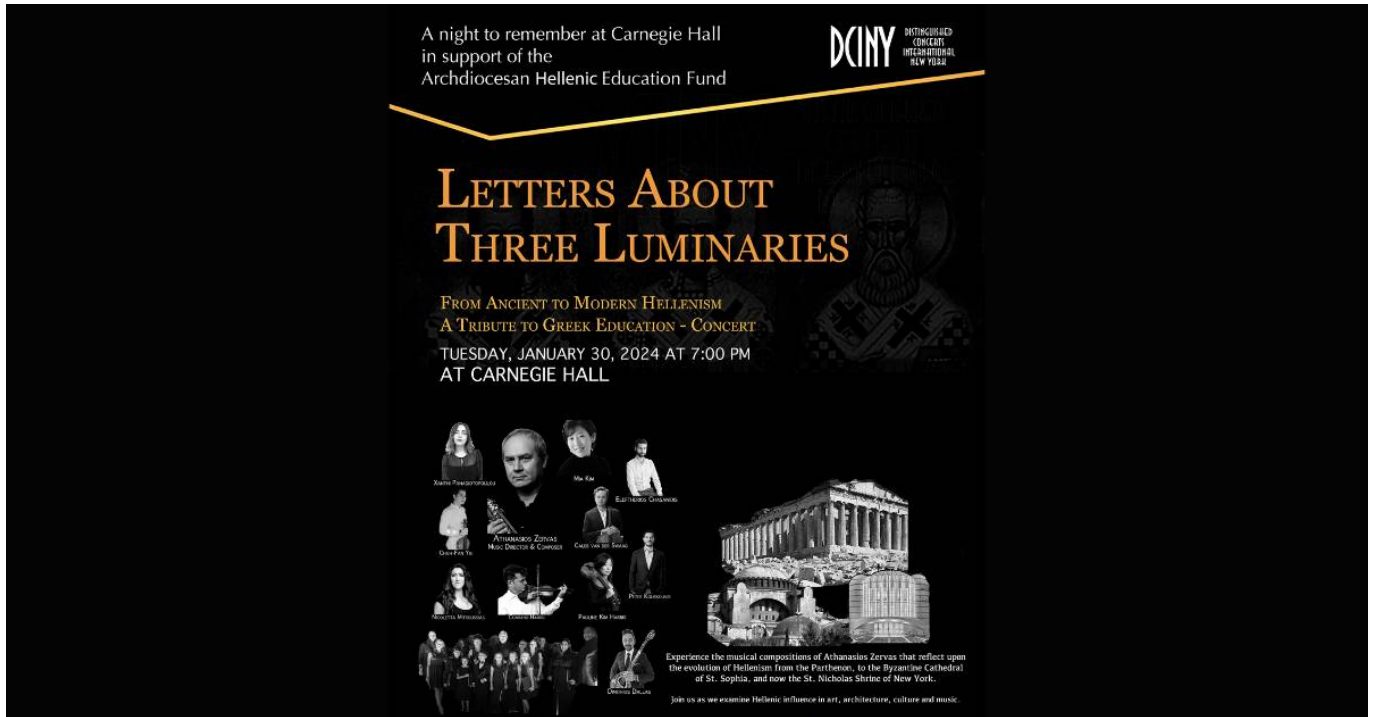


“Letters About Three Luminaries: The Music of Athanasios Zervas” Benefit Concert for the Hellenic Education Fund
